



ore than 1,400 people participated in the 13th Annual **Town** of Palm Beach United Way *Turkey Trot* on Thanksgiving Day at Bradley Park in Palm Beach. Sponsorships and registrations for the 5K run provided holiday meals to 4,167 Palm Beach County residents.

The event also featured a *Drumstick Dash* for children, music, costume contest, raffle drawings and awards ceremony. **Mackenzie Mettille**, 24, was the top overall male finisher with a time of 17:18. **Paris Stankewich**, 19, was the first female to cross the finish line in 20:05. About 50 first responders also participated in the event.

The *Turkey Trot* was made possible through the support of 57 sponsors and in-kind donors.
